# DRESS FOR THE WEATHER



Unless it is really miserable and so wet we can see rain bouncing off the pavement, we go outside at recess and long recess. If your child only has one pair of shoes, he or she will be wet all day. If you are having difficulty affording extra clothing so your child can stay dry, please let us know in the office and we may be able to help. Please send an extra pair of clothing including sock and mitts that your child can keep in their locker or cubby.

### TRAFFIC



As we are all aware, parking is at a premium and we all need to continue to be diligent to watch for students and other cars.

Staff parking is in the back lot behind the band building. The reason for this is that the road going in and out is only one lane so it is not conducive for drop off and pick up. When parents use this as a drop off area, there is congestion on that road as they try to leave while staff and other parents try to come in. The front parking lot is open for parents who need to park to walk their children to the door. This would be our Kindergarten students when

they arrive and some of our grade ones.

Most other students can be dropped off instead of looking for parking. This front lot is a better drop off area as you can drive through, stop for a moment and still leave room for cars to do the same behind you. As long as there are no busses in the bus loop (they arrive around 8:15, 8:20 and 8:33), this is also another safe drop off area. Please drive to the far end - the second bus gate - in case a bus does arrive or to give other families the same opportunity.

Supervision is provided in the yard for 15 minutes before and after school. The upper parking lot is quite empty about 10 minutes after school so another option is to arrange to meet your child a few minutes after dismissal or drop off before 8:30 if possible to let the cars move out of the way.

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As we have students and staff in our school with peanut allergies, please be aware of the food you are sending in and avoid peanuts specifically. - Fruit or assorted vegetables
- Dried fruit like raisins
- Cheese and certain crackers or rice cakes
- Pretzels, breadsticks, muffins (check ingredients)
- Yogurt or other milk products
- Homemade popcorn

#### **BUS PASSES**

Bus Passes have been distributed but there are still more to come. If your child did not get one yet and you have registered, it should be here next week. If you have not registered, please register through the transportation link on the school district website.

Students can ride the bus without the pass for the next couple of weeks until they are all delivered.

**NEW** \* changes to school bus service to Cedar Elementary and Cedar Secondary Schools from the South Wellington area (Bus Route 8). The bus stop at South Wellington Rd. and Morden Rd. has been deemed to be in a location that can jeopardize student safety. In order to correct this safety concern, it has been found necessary to adjust the bus service for students residing in the South Wellington area (Bus Route 8). There are changes to Bus Route 8 that will see bus service for students earlier in the mornings Monday to Friday. Please note that the former bus stop location of South Wellington Rd & Morden Rd is being eliminated, two new bus stop locations are being implemented in place of this bus stop. The new bus stop locations will be South Wellington School entrance & Dick Ave/Scotchtown Rd.

This bus route change is effective starting Monday September 18, 2017. After school bus service is not affected or changed. Bus drivers sent a note home with your child that list time changes.
