With changes to the curriculum, educators are finding new ways to engage students in their learning. In particular, educators are teaching Applied Design Skills Technology curriculum. ADST curriculum is an experiential, hands-on program of learning through design and creation that includes a variety of skills and concepts. To facilitate this type of learning, our intermediate divisions are holding a Kub Kar rally on March 11th in our school gym. Kub Kars are toy-racing cars built from kits. Each kit contains a block of pine, plastic wheels and metal axles. The students saw then sand, paint, and add other embellishments for both speed and style..
