- **Upcoming Eclipse** – Please see the information we have received from NLPS. Unlike the 2017 total solar eclipse in Oregon, Nanaimo will only see a 10% partial eclipse next Monday. <https://www.timeanddate.com/eclipse/in/canada/vancouver?iso=20240408>

For precautions:

- Do not look directly at the sun, the best way to see any part of the eclipse is by making a pin hole camera.
- Even if its cloudy, it should only be directly viewed using proper solar glasses.
- The NASA website will have a live broadcast of the eclipse (maximum eclipse 11:17 am Nanaimo time) and it has a great safety page. <https://science.nasa.gov/eclipses/future-eclipses/eclipse-2024/>
- It would be a good reminder to students that it is not safe to look directly at the sun without proper eye protection. We have not had any recommendations to keep students inside during this time here in BC.
