School Beach Day at Rathtrevor – Monday is our school wide beach day at Rathtrevor! We are excited to be taking the entire school on this adventure. Some very important notes to parents in order to ensure a safe, fun and happy day for all:

- 1. Permission forms were due on Wednesday. If you have yet to return the form, please note that we cannot take any students who do not have this returned by Monday 8:35am. Students without a signed permission form Monday at 8:35am will spend the day at the school with appropriate supervision.
- 2. Please have your child arrive to school on time Monday as the busses will be leaving immediately after the bell and attendance is taken.
- 3. Please ensure your child is prepared (clothing, food, sunscreen, water, umbrella, etc.) to spend the day at the beach, rain or shine! No electronic devices, cell phones, etc.
- 4. Outdoor equipment will be brought by staff. Students can bring only what will fit in their backpack.
- 5. CLEAR CONED OFF BOUNDARIES will be in place at the beach. Students are expected to stay within these boundaries the entire day. NO EXCEPTIONS! Within the boundaries there are tide pools. This is the ONLY water students will be allowed in. To be clear, there is NO GOING OUT TO THE BEACH AND SWIMMING, regardless of whether or not a parent is present.
- 6. Signing your child out if you would like to sign your child out and take them home with you, your child must check in with their classroom teacher before leaving.

- 7. FREE FREEZIE for everyone! Mr. Moynihan's class has organized and offered to hand out a free freezie to every student! If you do not want your child to have a freezie, please notify their teacher and also tell your child in advance so that they are aware of your request.
- 8. Encourage your child to follow our PACK expectations: Peaceful Problem Solvers, Aware and Responsible, Cooperative and Kind. By following our PACK expectations, we help to ensure the safety and well-being of all students and staff.
- 9. Lastly, encourage them to have a fun day at the beach!

**Summative Reports** will be emailed out on the last day of school. We encourage you to sit down with your student and celebrate all of their hard work this school year.
